

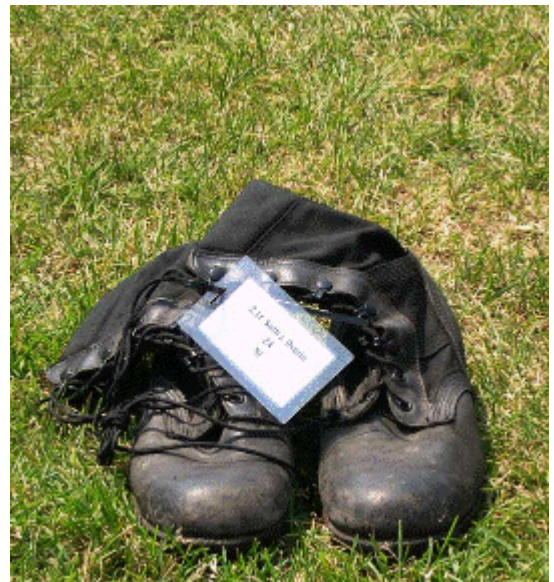


Eyes Wide Open: The Human Cost of War National Guard Memorial

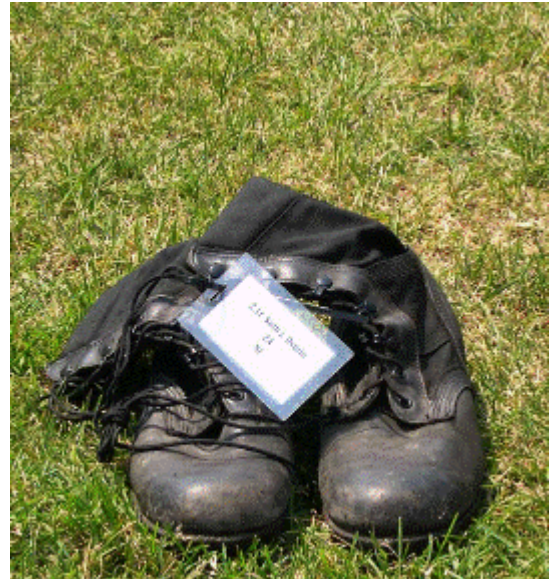
